# Teach *The American Revolution* Using the Power of Visual Storytelling

*The American Revolution*, from filmmakers Ken Burns, Sarah Botstein, and David Schmidt, examines how 13 colonies on the Atlantic Coast united in rebellion, won their independence, and established a republic that still endures. The series weaves together personal accounts of dozens of figures who waged and witnessed war, bringing these stories — and this shared history — to life in engaging ways.

An extension of this landmark series is now available to classrooms through ***The American Revolution Collection***, part of the **Ken Burns in the Classroom** hub on PBS LearningMedia.

The Hunter family's primary goal is to learn as much as they can about weather, to benefit the community and the planet by solving weather mysteries, sharing vital information, and encouraging stewardship of the environment. Among the key topics explored are observing and tracking weather patterns, investigating the weather at different times of the year and in different places around the world, and the connection between weather, humans, and their environment.



## PHOEBE & JAY (PK-K)

*Phoebe & Jay* follows the adventures of 6-year-old fraternal twins Phoebe and Jay Yarber, who live with their family in the fantastical Tobsy Towers. At the heart of *Phoebe & Jay* is a foundational literacy curriculum highlighting the importance of developing preschoolers' functional literacy and skills. From using a flyer to help a neighbor find a lost pet, to reading clothing labels to find the right size shirt, Phoebe & Jay model for young viewers how they, too, can use everyday texts to navigate their daily activities, develop important life skills, and communicate with others in their family and community.

## CARL THE COLLECTOR (K-2)

*Carl the Collector* follows the everyday adventures of Carl, a warm-hearted racoon with autism who enjoys collecting things and loves his friends and family in Fuzzytown. Carl pays attention to detail and comes up with unique ideas that others might not consider. These traits have helped him amass his extensive collections—from autographs and bottle caps to fake mustaches, pet rocks, sweaters, and more—which can come in handy for solving problems with his friends. With relatable stories from a neurodiverse production team, the series celebrates the idea that we all have something unique to offer.




