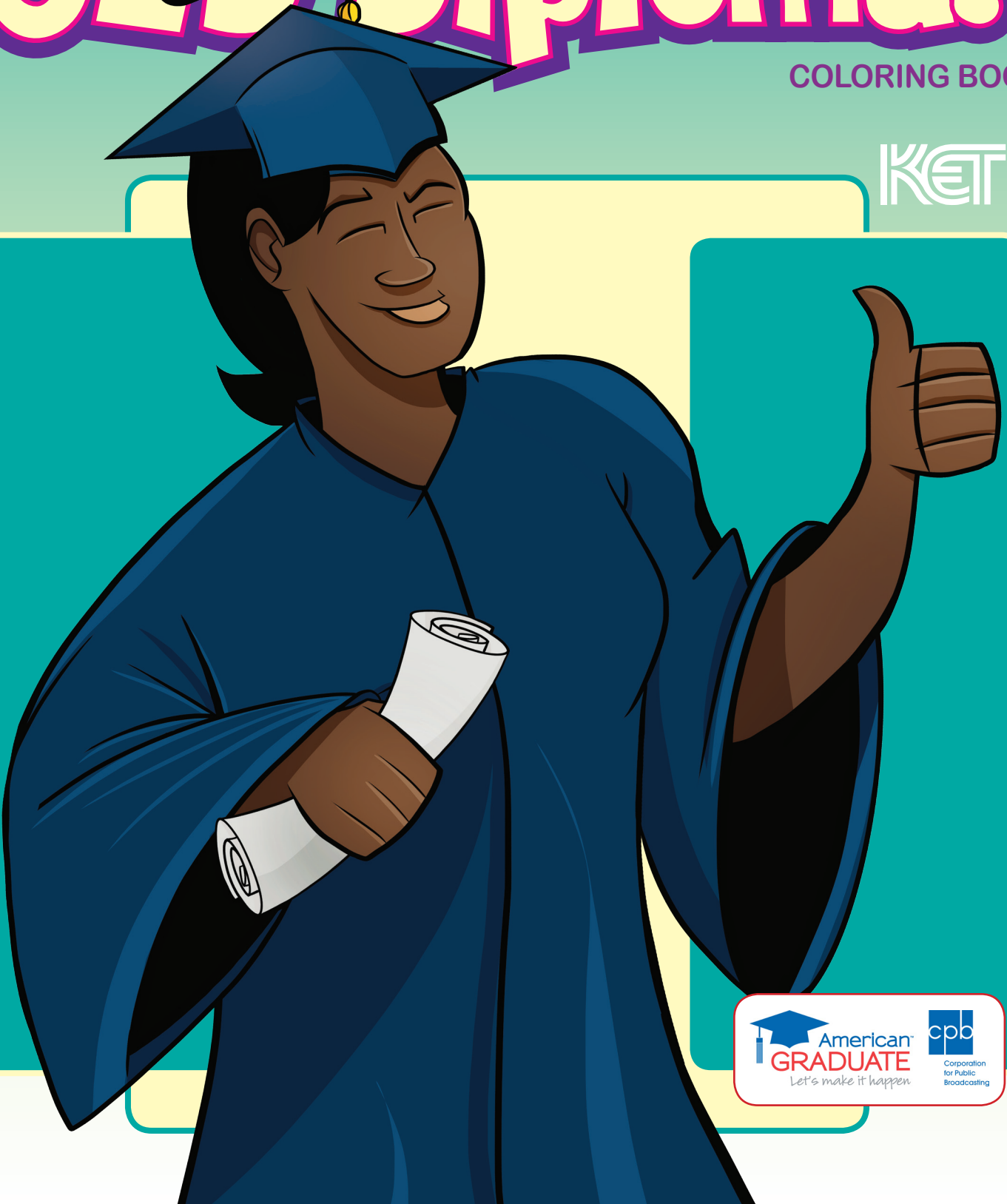


Kellie Gets a GED[®] Diploma!
