Make Art

Use wrapped canvas, construction paper, poster board, bottle caps, buttons, straws--anything on hand. Explore the area around your house--your yard or a park, for example--or your vacation spot. Find some natural things (rocks, sticks, leaves, etc.). Have each person contribute one thing they find.

Scavenger Hunt

Do a photo scavenger hunt where you live or vacation--try to find these things (remind your student to get photos of your search and what you see): Someone wearing a cowboy hat, someone eating an ice cream cone, someone skateboarding, a cat or dog looking out of a window, outside water (a puddle, creek, pool, etc.), etc.
